Introduction

DigDownload allows you to easily manage secure downloads on your DotNetNuke site.

Organization

Each module can have multiple sections, then in those sections you can have multiple files.



Security

There are different security settings for View and Download. The Module has default View and Download security that will be used for all the downloads in the module. You can override those settings on both the Section and on each File.

Installation

1. Login as host to your DotNetNuke portal.
2. Go to Host > Module Definitions or Host > Extensions
3. From the Module menu, select **Upload New Module** or **Install Extension Wizard**
4. Browse and upload the DigDownload.zip file you received.

After the install, the DigDownload will be available in the Modules drop down in the control panel at the top of your portal.

Upgrading

To upgrade to a newer version, just install the new version ontop of your existing module. If you uninstall first, you will loose all your data.

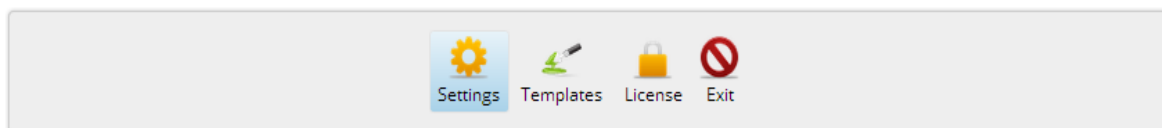
Do not Uninstall your existing module when upgrading, this will delete all your data. Just install on top of the existing module.

Uninstalling

1. Login as host to your DotNetNuke portal.
2. Go to **Host > Module Definitions** or **Host > Extensions**
3. Edit the DigDownload module by clicking the edit icon.
4. Click **Uninstall** or **Uninstall Extension** to uninstall DigDownload.

Template

The template will dictate the look and feel of your DigDownload module. You can find the templates in /DesktopModules/DigDownload/Templates.

If want to modify a template, it's best to copy an existing template into your own template directory so when you install an update to DigDownload, it won't overwrite your template changes.

Sort

Choose the sort order, you can sort by Upload Date, File Size and Download Count

Custom Label

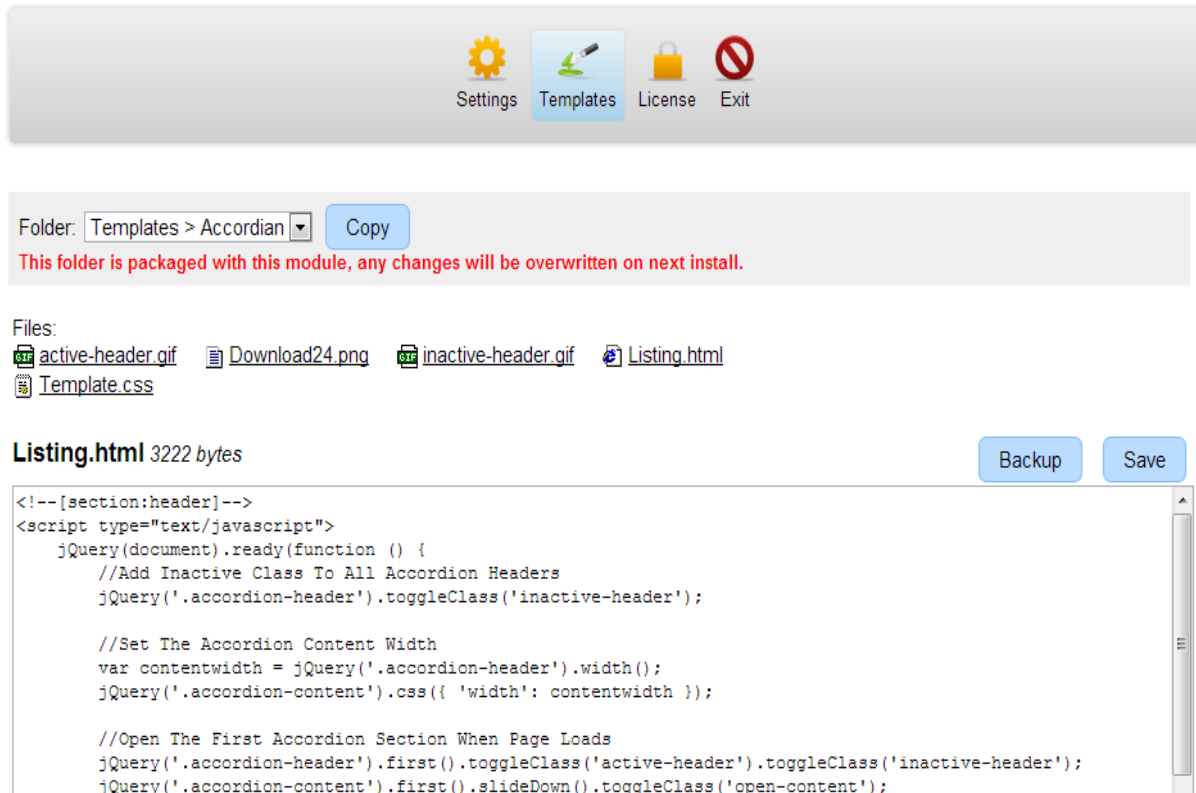
You have 3 custom text fields that can be used in DigDownload. Specify the label for the custom field. If you blank out the label, the custom field will be hidden.

Default Security

This is the default security for all the sections and files in the module.

Templates

DigDownload contains a built-in template editor to make it easier to customize your DigDownload templates and styles.



Folder

This is the folder you are currently editing. You can copy the folder to a new folder.

DigDownload will tell you when you are editing a template that is part of DigDownload and will be overwritten the next time you install an update to DigDownload.

Backup

Backup will copy the current template file you are editing to a backup. For example Listing.html will be copied to Listing.bak.html.

Templates

DigDownload is template driven, you can find the template in the Templates folder.

Listing.html

This is the main display for the DigDownload module. Listing.html has a few sections:

- [section:header] – Header of the entire module
- [section:footer] – Footer of the entire module
- [section:sectionheader] – Header of the Section
- [section:sectionfooter] – Footer of the Section
- [section:sectionnoview] – This is displayed when the user does not have view access to the section
- [section:fileheader] – Header of the sections of files
- [section:file] – Displayed for each file
- [section:filefooter] – Footer of the section of files.

Tags

Tags are the elements inside the template files that allow you to insert information about the contest or entry.






Key	Description
	<p>Condition item. You always need a matching ending tag</p> <p>Example:</p> <pre>[hascond] Is True [/hascond] [hascond:not] Not True [/hascond]</pre>
	<p>Date item. You can specify a valid .net date format string. Or 'ago' to display dates like '3 hours ago'</p> <p>Example:</p> <pre>[birthdate:F] displays Thursday, April 10, 2008 6:30:00 AM [birthdate:ago] displays 31 years 5 days ago</pre>
	<p>DotNetNuke user. You can display the following information: id, firstname, lastname, fullname, displayname, gravatarurl:size:rating:type, gravatar:size:rating:type, avatar:width:height, avatarurl:width:height</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gravatar size, rating, and type are optional. Defaults are 89, G, 'monsterid'. For more info, please visit gravatar.com. Software License Agreement for DigDownload
