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

Introduction

DigPageLinks allows you to create a list of links for any pages in your DotNetNuke site. DigPageLinks uses the Page Security and Begin / End dates that are defined on the DNN Pages.

Installation

1. Login as host to your DotNetNuke portal.
2. Go to Host > Module Definitions or Host > Extensions
3. From the Module menu, select **Upload New Module** or **Install Extension Wizard**
4. Browse and upload the DigPageLinks.zip file you received.

After the install, the DigPageLinks will be available in the Modules drop down in the control panel at the top of your portal.

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Upgrading

To upgrade to a newer version, just install the new version on top of your existing module. If you uninstall first, you will lose all your data.


Do not Uninstall your existing module when upgrading, this will delete all your data. Just install on top of the existing module.

Uninstalling

1. Login as host to your DotNetNuke portal.
2. Go to **Host > Module Definitions** or **Host > Extensions**
3. Edit the DigPageLinks module by clicking the edit icon.
4. Click **Uninstall** or **Uninstall Extension** to uninstall DigPageLinks.

DigPageLinks Setup

Settings – Page Data

Mode

- Children on this page – Children of the current page
- Siblings of this page – Siblings (pages on the same level) of this page
- Children of another page – Children of the selected page
- Children of another page (also include selected page) – Includes the children of the selected page and the selected page itself.

Include Hidden

- Include pages that are set to not be included in the DNN Menu

Include Disabled

- Include pages that are marked as disabled in the DNN Menu


Include Children


Specify how many levels deep of children you want to include.

Flatten Pages

Selecting this option will flatten out the pages, removing any hierarchy that is assigned to the pages.

Template

Select a Template that defines the layout of your PageLinks menu.

If you want to modify a template, it's best to copy an existing template into your own template directory so when you install an update to DigPageLinks, it won't overwrite your template changes.

Select Top Visible Parent

In the template you will see a tag [page:isselected] used to highlight the selected page. If a Child page that is not visible in the PageLinks menu is selected and this option is enabled, the first visible parent will be highlighted.

Header


■ This content will be inserted where the [header] tag is used in the templates

Footer

■ This content will be inserted where the [footer] tag is used in the templates

Settings – Pages

The Pages area allows you to set individual settings for each page in your menu. This allows great customization of your PageLinks menu.

Override Template

In the Listing.html template file, there is a section titled “page”, this defines how the content will display. If you select Override Template, what you enter here will replace what is used in the “page” section of the Listing.html. You can click the “information” icon to see your template choices.

Override Page Name

This lets you easily override the name of the page to be something else in the menu. It will be used for the [page:name] token in the templates.

Hide

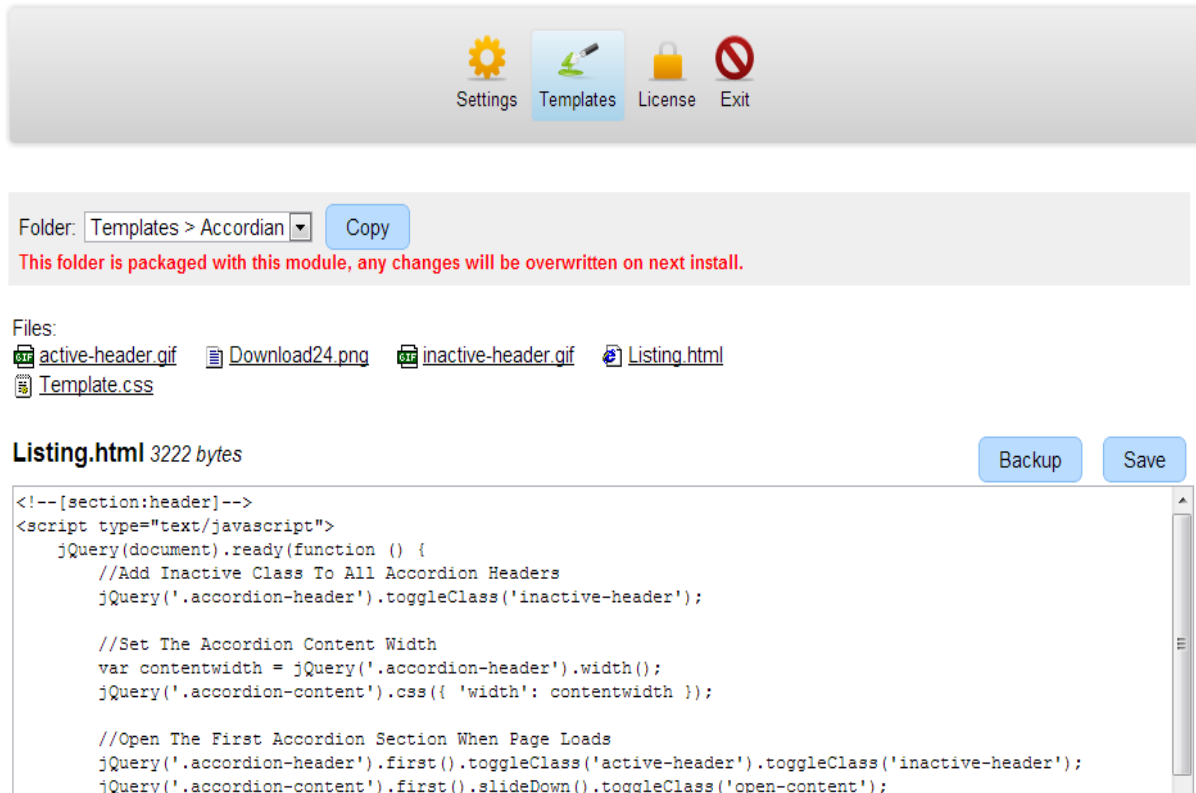
Do not hide – will show the page

This Page Only – will hide this page, but still show it's children

This Page and Children – will hide this page and all it's children.

Templates

DigPageLinks contains a built-in template editor to make it easier to customize your DigPageLinks templates.



Folder

This is the folder you are currently editing. You can copy the folder to a new folder. DigPageLinks will tell you when you are editing a template that is part of DigPageLinks and will be overwritten the next time you install an update to DigPageLinks.

Backup

Backup will copy the current template file you are editing to a backup. For example Listing.html will be copied to Listing.bak.html.

Templates

DigPageLinks is template driven, you can find the template in the Templates folder.

Listing.html

This is the main display for the DigPageLinks module. Listing.html has a few sections:

[section:header] – Header of the entire module

[section:footer] – Footer of the entire module

[section:sectionheader] – Header of the Section

[section:parentheader] – Header Parent Section

[section:parentfooter] – Footer of Parent Section

[section:sectionfooter] – Footer of the Section

[section:notiems] – This is displayed when there are not menu items

[section:page] – Displayed for each page

Rendering Order

Tags

Tags are the elements inside the template files that allow you to insert information about the page.




Key	Description
	<p>Condition item. You always need a matching ending tag</p> <p>Example:</p> <pre>[hascond] Is True [/hascond] [hascond:not] Not True [/hascond]</pre>
	<p>Date item. You can specify a valid .net date format string. Or 'ago' to display dates like '3 hours ago'</p> <p>Example:</p> <pre>[birthdate:F] displays Thursday, April 10, 2008 6:30:00 AM [birthdate:ago] displays 31 years 5 days ago</pre>
	<p>DotNetNuke user. You can display the following information: id, firstname, lastname, fullname, displayname, gravatarurl:size:rating:type, gravatar:size:rating:type, avatar:width:height, avatarurl:width:height</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gravatar size, rating, and type are optional. Defaults are 89, G, 'monsterid'. For more info, please visit gravatar.com. Avatar tag uses the avatar setting in system settings. <p>Examples:</p> <pre>[user:id] [user:displayname] [user:gravatar:30]</pre>
	<p>Url must be used in an <a> tag.</p> <pre></pre>

[page:name]		Name of the page
[page:description]		Description of the page
[page:leve]		Level number. Top level number is 0, next level is 1
[page:islevel:level]		Is the page level number {level}
[page:url]		URL of the page
[page:haschildren]		Does the current page have children
[page:ishidden]		Is the current page hidden
[page:isdisabled]		Is the current page disabled
[page:icon]		Small icon image
[page:largeicon]		Large icon image
[page:id]		DNN ID of the Page

[header]		Header text defined in the DigPageLinks settings
[footer]		Footer text defined in the DigPageLinks settings
